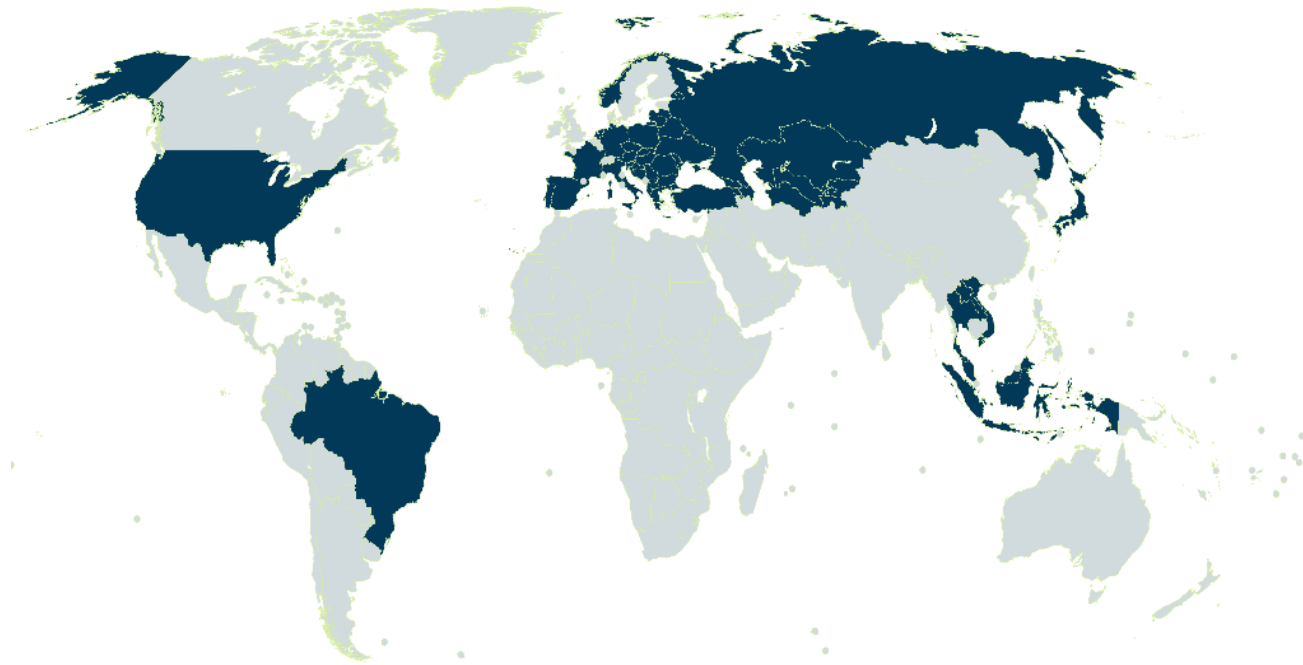
Over project activities RCISD also provide
