## **Background**

The Smartpolis Consortium led by the Hungarian Intellectual Property Office, the Budapest University of Technology and Economics (BME ) together with the Fraunhofer Fokus Institute (Berlin) and the Urban Software Institute (Chemnitz-Darmstadt) started planning the Smartpolis project under Phase 2 of the Horizon 2020 Teaming call with the aim of establishing a Regional Smart City Center of Excellence (Smartpolis). The goal of the project is to catalyze and support smart city related activities in the region. The Centre plans to focus on projects and work with researchers from the Central and Eastern European region. The Consortium is preparing to submit a proposal for the Phase 2 of the Horizon 2020 Teaming call in November. In case of winning this tender Smartpolis will also financially support smart city activities in the CEE countries.

## **Invitation**

We would like to invite you for the “ Third Smartpolis Workshop“ which aims to facilitate and develop beneficial co-operation between key stakeholders in Central and Eastern Europe (CEE) in the field of smart cities.

In the workshop last year we had representatives from several countries like: Slovenia, Slovakia, Serbia, Germany, Poland and several cities, universities and multinational companies from Hungary. Fifteen organizations signed the letter of intent to establish the Smart City Forum for the CEE countries.
